Disability FAQs

1. How do I apply for disability benefits, social security benefits, food stamps, or WIC?
There are several ways to apply. You can apply online at commonhelp.virginia.gov, or call 855-635-4370, or apply in person at Lynchburg Human Services located at 99 9th Street. No appointment required.
2. I have a physical disability. What programs am I eligible for?
You can get on the RUSH Homes waiting list. RUSH Homes are affordable housing for those with physical disabilities. To get on the waitlist visit rushhomes.org or call 434-455-2120.
You can also contact DARS, an employment agency for those with disabilities. They can connect you with a job that can accommodate you. Visit them at 2250 Murrell Rd. Suite F Lynchburg VA or call then at 434-947-6721.
3. Am I eligible for monthly disability benefits? I have diagnosed with a mental health disorder and/or have a chronic physical condition.
Maybe! Visit Lynchburg Human Services located at 99 9th Street and ask a social worker there.
4. I have been diagnosed with a mental health disorder. What programs am I eligible for?
You are eligible for Horizon's Housing Program. You also may be eligible for free counseling, and Horizon's case management, psychiatric care, and counseling programs. You can do a walk in meeting at Horizon by visiting 2215 Langhorne Rd. Lynchburg VA or you can call to schedule an appointment at 434-477-5000.
